Labelling Possessions

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Common Cold Symptoms & Causes

Symptoms of a common cold usually appear one to three days after exposure to a cold-causing virus. Signs and symptoms, which can vary from person to person, might include:

Runny or stuffy nose, sore throat, cough congestion, slight body aches or a mild headache, Sneezing, low-grade fever, generally feeling unwell (malaise). The discharge from your nose may become thicker and yellow or green in color as a common cold runs its course. This isn't an indication of a bacterial infection.

When to see a doctor - in general, your child doesn't need to see the doctor for a common cold. But seek medical attention right away if your child has any of the following:

Fever of 38°C in newborns up to 12 weeks, rising fever or fever lasting more than two days in a child of any age, symptoms that worsen or fail to improve, severe symptoms, such as headache or cough, wheezing, ear pain, extreme fussiness, unusual drowsiness, lack of appetite

Causes

Although many types of viruses can cause a common cold, rhinoviruses are the most common culprit. A cold virus enters your body through your mouth, eyes or nose. The virus can spread through droplets in the air when someone who is sick coughs, sneezes or talks. It also spreads by hand-to-hand contact with someone who has a cold or by sharing contaminated objects, such as utensils, towels, toys or telephones. If you touch your eyes, nose or mouth after such contact or exposure, you're likely to catch a cold.
